Abstract

Higher Education-Private Aided Colleges-Exemption from acquiring the qualification of Pass in Attender test to the Laboratory/Library Assistants who have crossed 50 years and does not possess the requisite qualification as per Statutes, as on the time of appointment and whose approval were given conditionally-Sanctioned-Orders issued.

ORDER

Vide Order read as 1st above, Government have issued orders that all members of Non-Teaching Staff in Aided Colleges who have attained the age of 50 years shall stand permanently exempted from passing the obligatory Attender Test conducted by the Kerala Public Service Commission, as stipulated in Statutes of concerned Universities.

Now it has come to the notice that there exists a doubt in the matter whether such exemption can be extended to those who does not possess the requisite qualification of Pass in Attender Test, but were appointed by the Manager directly as Library/Laboratory Assistant and their approval were later given on condition that they should pass attender test within three chances and until then they will be given pay in the scale of Last Grade Servants only.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to extend the relaxation given vide Government Order read as 1st above to the incumbents belonging to the above category also, as and when they crosses the 50 years of age.
